

INSTALLATION

EXS24: Make your choice between the 16 and 24 bits version of The Old Lady and run the OLD LADY 24 or OLD LADY EXS24 16 sitx installer.

EXS24 sitx installer files.

Stuffit X is name of the new format, and Stuffit X archives have a file extension of .sitx. You can use Stuffit X archives on any version of the Mac OS from 8.6 to 9.x, and any version of Mac OS X. You can also use Stuffit X archives on Windows.

Stuffit X archives cannot be expanded by older versions of Stuffit Deluxe or Stuffit Expander. In order to expand a Stuffit X archive, you must have a copy of at least Stuffit Expander 7.0 installed. To make your life easier, **Stuffit Expander is free** to any Macintosh or PC user. If you need a copy of Stuffit Expander, visit their website: <http://www.stuffit.com/expander>

Make your choice between the 16 and 24 bits version of The Old Lady and run the OLD LADY 24 or OLD LADY EXS24 16 sitx installer. The location where samples are stored in the new Logic Pro 7 edition is:

Macintosh HD>Library>Application Support>Logic>Sampler Instruments. You can also install the Old Lady anywhere else on your hard drive and place a shortcut (alias) in this folder. The instruments will show up in EXS24 after a launching the program.

memory usage notes for EXS24:

EXS24 Memory: We found that a modern Mac (G5 single CPU with 3 GB of RAM) can have difficulties playing the 24 wave-pool. To overcome this problem we suggest the following: Install and use the 16 bit wavepool version for tracking.

When you want to freeze the track, load the 24 bit piano and make a freeze off-line. Or consider using more RAM.
